<u>General Information</u>: The show usually features about 120 exhibitors, offering products and services relevant to all aspects of the agricultural community, with attendance ranging between 8,000 – 10,000 people. The main show takes place over approximately 10 acres, with over 40 acres in use featuring field demonstrations and fun activities. <u>Set-Up</u>: Setting up is the responsibility of the exhibitor. Exhibitors can begin setting up by noon on Wednesday. All exhibitors must be set up by 8:30 am Fri morning. Outside exhibitors with large equipment can make special arrangements to set up over the weekend if desired. (Please note – If you are bringing in large equipment, it becomes much more difficult to do so closer to the start of the show, therefore we suggest this equipment be brought in by Tue - Wed.) The Farm Show strives to make this a positive experience for the participants; being as helpful as possible, but we do not have the resources to assist with loading/unloading. Thankfully, it's a friendly bunch, and in the past other participants have generously extended the services of their equipment to help out, however this is at their discretion and we can't offer any guarantees. **Parking:** There is limited parking of 50 spaces next to the main buildings.
